Your name will be placed on the ballot if you are a Member of the Association, and you submit the completed Form. There will be five (5) positions on the Board up for election in 2026. Four (4) positions are each for a 2-year term and (1) position is for a 1-year term. **You must submit the completed Form so that it is physically received by Leyendecker Management Services on or before close of business on January 12, 2026, to have your name placed on the ballot.**

A candidate who is interested in running for a position on the Board must be available to attend Board meetings, plus allow additional hours each week for Association projects, working on owner/resident issues, reading and answering emails, attending training sessions, plus serving in an appointed capacity such as an officer on the Board or a liaison to an Association committee.

If you submit the Solicitation of Candidates Form, your form will be distributed to the Members of the Association, along with the 2026 Annual Meeting materials, prior to the Annual Meeting on Wednesday, February 25, 2026, at 6:30 p.m. (check-in at 6:00 p.m.) at Memorial Drive United Methodist Church, 12955 Memorial Drive, Houston, TX 77079, in the Youth Lounge.

Please note that the Texas Property Code (“Code”) disqualifies a person from serving on the Board of Directors for a property owners’ association if the person has been convicted of a felony or crime involving moral turpitude in the past twenty (20) years. In addition, the Code prohibits two (2) persons who live in the same residence from serving on the Board of Directors at the same time.
